PHOTON® HOLSTER BACKER ASSEMBLY

- 1 Place your unloaded firearm into the Photon™ Holster.
- 2 Position the backer on the body-side of the holster and align mounting holes.
 - Backer should shield the rear of the slide from your body
 - Must NOT interfere with your master grip
 - Designed to be trimmed for custom fit
- 3 Remember hole alignment & remove firearm from holster.
- 4 Insert weld nuts from the inside (firearm side) of the holster.
- 5 Place the backer over the weld nuts. Install flange screws and tighten evenly. Do not overtighten.
- 6 Trim the backer carefully for comfort and grip clearance. Reinstall and recheck fit.

Practice holstering and drawing your handgun, and wearing your holster, with your handgun unloaded until you are comfortable with fit, compatibility, and usage, before using your holster in non-test conditions or with a loaded handgun. Make certain that your handgun is securely seated in the holster each time you holster your handgun before removing your hand from the grip. A handgun must snugly fit in its holster to guard against accidental separation of the handgun from the holster. Never place your hand in front of the firearm barrel while trying to holster or un-holster your firearm. Keep your finger off the trigger until you are ready to shoot. Keep fingers off the trigger and out of the trigger guard when drawing or replacing the handgun in the holster and at all times while your handgun is holstered.

[Follow all instructions and guidance in your Alien Gear Holsters product Use and Care Guide/Instruction Manual/Owner's Manual.] Should your holster become worn, loose, defective, or ill-fitting at any time, immediately cease use of your holster and contact Alien Gear Holsters for warranty coverage instructions.
