Begin by removing the existing recoil pad from your stock by using a Phillips Head Screwdriver. Next use a long Flat Head Screwdriver or the appropriate socket with extension to remove the stock bolt from the inside of the opening in the rear of the stock as seen in Figure 1.



After installing the small TFS pin, flip the stock over and install the small TFS washer and using a Phillips Head Screwdriver, tighen the provided Phillips Head Screw as seen in Figure 4.



Attach the buttplate to the end of the arm as seen in Figure 2



To attach the pistol grip, slide the grip into the arm as seen in Figure 5, making sure the folding button is seated into the proper location.



Next, install the small TFS pin into the buttplate as seen in Figure 3.



Winchester Remington Adapter Adapter Select the correct adapter for your shotgun. The Mossberg and Maverick require no adapters. The Remington/Norinco and Winchester adapters are marked. Next, select the appropriate mounting bolt supplied for your shotgun as seen in Figure 6.

Place the appropriate bolt with supplied washer through the back of the grip and adapter (if used) as seen in Figure 7.

Next, intall the swivel stud and thread in until finger tight as seen in Figure 11.



Secure the bolt to the receiver by using the proper allen wrench as seen in Figure 8.



Using a 5/16 open face wrench and 3/16 allen wrench tighten until snug as seen in Figure 12. NOTE: WHEN TIGHTENING, DO NOT EXCEED 10LBS OF TORQUE.



Before installing the large TFS pin detemine which side you would like to have the swivel stud attached to as it will attach on the opposite side of the installed pin.. Next install the large TFS pin into the arm/ pistol grip as seen in Figure 9.



If the top folding arm is not sitting flush against the shotgun receiver, use a file or dremel tool to remove material from the notch on the top of the folding arm as seen in Figure 13. File and check often against the receiver for the proper



Turn the stock over and install the large TFS washer as seen in Figure 10.
