
ILLUMINATED MICROSCOPE INSTRUCTIONS



- Eyepiece
- 2. Battery cover
- 3. Focusing Wheel
- 4. Light Condenser
- 5. Light Switch
- 6. Bulb
- 7. Transparent Cover

OPERATION

- 1. Place the transparent cover (7) on the object.
- 2. Position the hole over the area to be viewed.
- 3. Slide the light switch (5) to the ON position and slide down the light condenser (4) to concentrate the light on the object being viewed.
- 4. Look through the eye piece (1) and turn the focus wheel (3) until the object is in sharp focus.
- 5. When viewing is completed, turn the light switch (5) to the OFF position and retract the light condenser (4).

BATTERY REPLACEMENT

- 1. Remove the battery cover (2) by sliding it in the direction indicated by the arrow.
- 2. Remove the exhausted batteries and replace with two new AA batteries.
- 3. Replace the battery cover.

BULB REPLACEMENT

- Remove the transparent cover (7) by sliding it in the direction shown in the illustration.
 (Note: The light condenser (4) must be retracted)
- 2. Unscrew the exhausted bulb and replace with a new one.
- 3. Replace the transparent cover.
