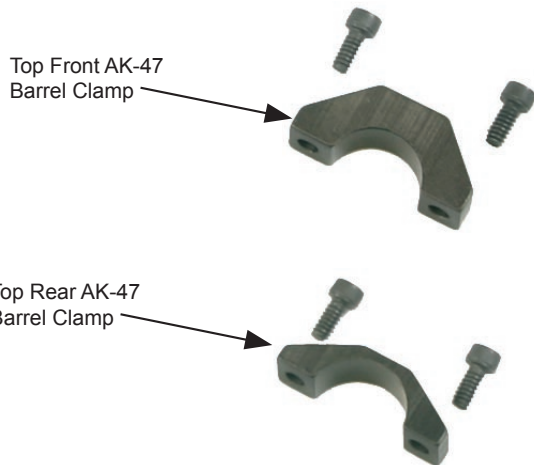

Installation of the Mount

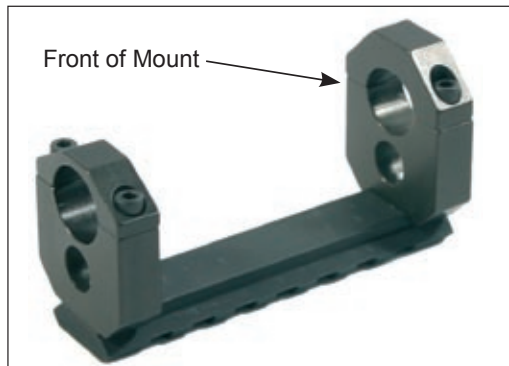

Step 1. Confirm that your weapon is completely unloaded (check the chamber and the magazine).

Step 2. Attach the mount on the barrel of the AK-47 making sure that the taller mounting clamp is positioned on the front of barrel. See Figure 1, above and Figure 2, p. 4.

Step 3. Securely tighten the hex screws located on each mounting clamp. See Figure 3, p. 4.
